### KS1 Explanation

- At the end of Key Stage 1 the minimum national expectation is Working At Age Related Expectations (WA)
- A child working well above the level for this year group is termed Working at Greater Depth (WAGD)
- In KS1, the attainment expectation grades are Teacher Assessment (TA) using tests to support this grading process.
- Combined scores allow us to ascertain if children have reached the expected level for KS1.

### KS2 Explanation

- Children working well above the expected level for this age band, are graded Working Greater Depth.(WAGD)
- Combined Reading, Writing and Maths are how we measure if a child leaves with the expected level for secondary school.
