In this warm weather please ensure your children **wear sunscreen, and bring a hat and a water bottle** to school.

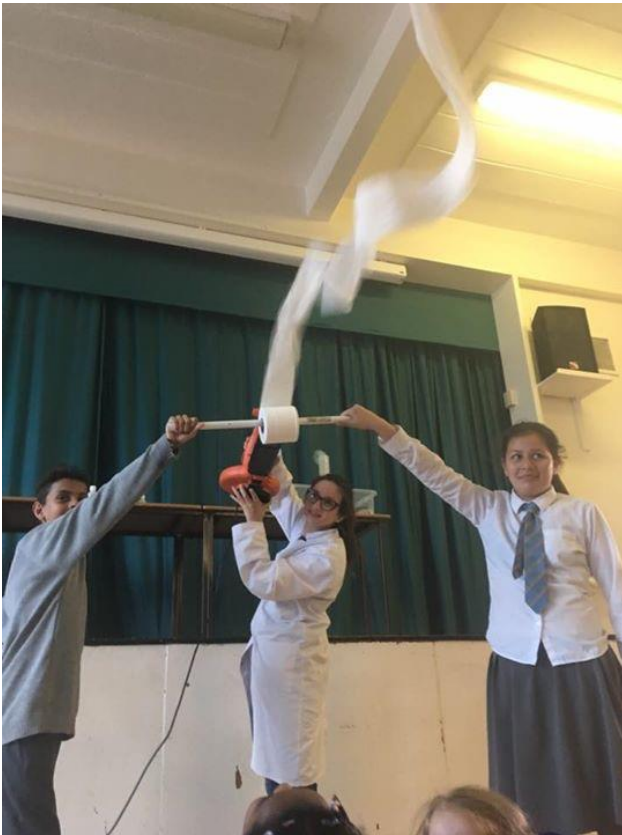
Also please ensure that children **still come to school in uniform** even when it is very hot.
