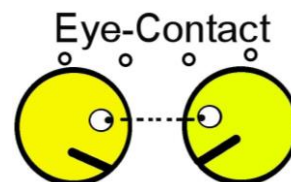
Parent/Teacher meetings (all years except Year 6) will be scheduled for the first week back after Easter.
