Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 6

Dear Parents/Carers

We hope you are keeping safe and well.

This month, we began the phased reopening of our school for Nursery, Reception, Year 1, and Year 6 pupils. This has been most successful, and it is lovely to have children back with us learning and playing with their friends.

In light of the latest government guidance, we would now like to invite more pupils back at school before the **end of term on 17th July 2020**.

We are therefore exploring the option to allow other year groups to return. However, there is a limit to the number of children who can be in school at one time, so it is important that we know how many children to expect in order to make our plans.

Therefore, if your child is in Nursery, Reception, Year 1 or 6 and has not yet come back to school, but you would like to start sending them in before the summer holidays, please let us know by 9am on Thursday 25th June 2020. The last return date for children in these year groups will be Monday 29th June.

We appreciate that for many of you, sending your child back to school might still be an anxious decision. But please rest assured, a great deal of detailed work has been and preparation has been put in place to implement all of the measures needed to make school as safe as it can be for our pupils and staff.

Classes – known as bubbles - have no more than 15 children and bubbles do not mix with any other groups; each bubble has assigned adults. The times children arrive and leave school are staggered and lunch and toilet breaks are organised to prevent children mixing with others from outside their bubble.

Those children who have come back are really enjoying being back at school, and their teachers are so delighted to see them.

If you decide that your child will not return, of course, they will be able to continue with their home learning.
